

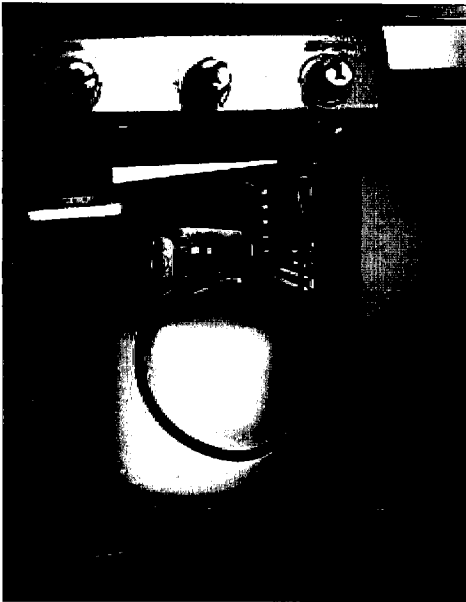

IMPORTANT SAFETY TIPS

CARBON MONOXIDE

C.V. Oil Co. Inc. urges all of its customers to install carbon monoxide detectors and to never ignore an alarming CO alarm.

Carbon monoxide is a deadly, colorless, odorless, poisonous gas. It is produced by the incomplete burning of various fuels. Carbon monoxide poisoning can mimic flu symptoms such as headaches, dizziness, nausea and fatigue. Higher levels of exposure result in disorientation, drowsiness, unconsciousness and death. Common sources of carbon monoxide include heating appliances, water heaters, clothes dryers, emergency generators, temporary cooking appliances or space heaters and motor vehicles running in attached garages or adjacent to a building.

Always make sure vents are clear of snow & ice and batteries are charged annually.

UNVENTED FUEL- FIRED HEATERS

Unvented room heaters can no longer to be used. Unvented heaters are strictly prohibited in "public buildings." Public buildings include any building that is rented short or long term.

SEASONAL/UNOCCUPIED HOMES

No matter how you heat your home, maintaining your heat to a certain level is critical. Freeze-ups in an occupied/empty or unoccupied dwelling or home can cause expensive losses. Water from broken pipes can flood a house in a matter of hours causing structural damage to the house and loss of personal property.

Remember that you have a responsibility to protect your home against damage arising from a drop in or loss of heat. This scenario can result in frozen pipes and water damage.

It is important to arrange for supervision of your home if you plan to be away from the property. Houses need to be checked daily during the winter months.

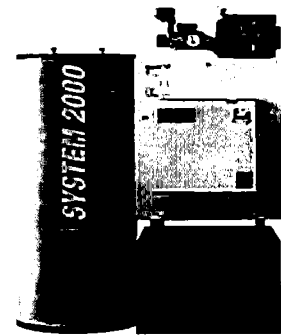
will be kept warm through the cold winter months.
